- 1st semester: from January to August. We accept applications from September and October, and we will respond in mid-November.

- 2nd semester: from August to January. We accept applications from March to April, and we will respond in mid-May.

You will be working with a range of exciting tools and processes, from material innovation to masterplans, from forensic material studies to co-design workshops, which will develop unique and valuable skills.
